The Fairbridge Programme is a **FREE** Personal Development Programme for young people aged **16 – 25** who are currently unemployed or who lack the skills or confidence to engage in full time training or education

ACCESS – Is an introductory week where the young people will take part in activities such as climbing, raft-building and a two night residential. Young People also have the opportunity to achieve the Prince's Trust Personal Development and Employability skills qualification

FOLLOW-ON – is an individually tailored journey where young people pick and choose the sessions they want to attend. What kind of activities do we offer?

MOVING ON – When the time is right for the young people to leave the programme they are supported into positive outcomes and will received 3 months of follow up support from their dedicated worker

Get Started with Motor Vehicles

Taster Day: 20th July Main Course: Monday 24th – Friday 28th July

The Prince's Trust in partnership with Hampshire Fire and Rescue Service will be running a Get Started programme themed around Motor Vehicles. **'Get Started with Motor Vehicles'** will run at St Mary's Fire station between 24th – 28th July 2017 for young people aged between 16-25 who are living in Southampton or the close surrounding areas who are currently **NEET (not in employment, education or training)**.

Free 5 day "Motor Vehicles" course where young people can:

- Develop technical motor vehicle skills with a qualified trainer
- Work as a group to design and build your own go-kart
- Learn more about the industry
- Meet new people and improve your communication and teamwork skills
- Receive up to three months' progression support with The Prince's Trust to help you find further training or work

This course is entirely free, we also reimburse travel costs and provide lunch throughout the programme.

Interested, referred and assessed young people will be invited to a taster day at St Mary's Fire station on Thursday 20th July to find out more about the course, meet the group, decide if the course is for them and complete course paperwork.

Vehicle Banksman

As a learner you will work towards the following qualifications in order to gain your certification:

**Health and Safety In the Workplace Level 2 Award
City and Guilds Employability Skills
Banksman (Vehicle Marshall)**

A Vehicle Banksman is the person who oversees directing the movements of large vehicles on a work site, particularly large cranes during loading and unloading.

A Vehicle Banksman is the eyes and ears of the crane or truck driver and makes sure any manoeuvres they make are safe and don't put the driver or anyone else in danger.

The Banksman communicates with the driver via a radio link or pre-arranged hand signals. By doing this the Banksman can inform the driver of what is going on around the vehicle since they may not have a complete view or clear visibility.

A Vehicle Banksman can also be called upon for many other duties such as directing traffic in and around the site.

- 19+
- Must be unemployed and claiming benefits (JSA / ESA / UC / IS)
- Must have ID
- Must be motivated to find work
- Must complete a literacy and numeracy assessment
- Previous experience is not required

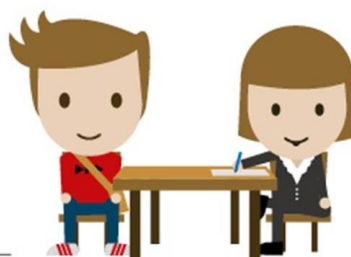
