### **SAFE Wellbeing Choices Course**

**When: Starts Wednesday 8th November 2017**

**Where: 1st Floor Dukes Keep, Marsh Lane, Southampton, SO14 3EX**

This course is designed for people aged 18 – 65 adults who are either long-term unemployed or who have confidence and self-esteem issues.

Candidates have often attended other formal provision for confidence and employability but have been unable to benefit from it.

The clients we work with face multiple barriers to employment around confidence, self-esteem, depression and anxiety, physical conditions and attitudinal barriers caused by feeling institutionalised and out of control.

Wellbeing Choices will help them face their barriers and bring about increased motivation and transformed thinking, attitude and behaviour so they can get the maximum benefit from Work Coach/Key Worker support to progress into employment, training or community involvement.

It will help them plan for realistic and fulfilling work that matches their strengths, skills and motivations.

It is for those struggling with low confidence, self-esteem and motivation but who want to change their situation and progress in their lives.

The course will enable them to identify their skills and strengths, along with a healthy way of thinking about themselves and their situation so that their motivation increases.

Although Wellbeing Choices is an intensive 50-hour programme, it is delivered in a relational, informal and interactive way. Travel expenses are reimbursed and lunch and refreshments are provided. The course will be run in Dukes Keep Marsh Lane Southampton on the following dates between 10am and 3.30pm:

- Wednesday 8th November & Thursday 9th November
- Wednesday 15th November & Thursday 16th November
- Wednesday 22nd November & Thursday 23rd November
- Wednesday 29th November & Thursday 30th November
- Wednesday 6th November & Thursday 7th November
- Followed by three half day support and action planning sessions
